- Camp College Organize, administer, and promote annual Playground Camp College event held in June before camps begin.
- Hershey Track & Field Organize, administer, and promote annual Hershey Track event on district, county and state levels.
- Hot Shots Competitions Organize, administer, and promote annual Hot Shots event on district, county and state levels.
